### **SECOND AMENDED INTERIM ORDER RE: MODIFICATIONS TO COURT OPERATIONS**

---

This Second Amended Interim Order Re: Modifications To Court Operations amends that certain "Amended Interim Order Re: Modifications To Court Operations" to address the management and scheduling of arraignments and court trials in traffic and non-traffic infraction proceedings, (where the infraction charge is not joined with misdemeanor or felony charges in the same criminal case). Except as expressly amended or supplemented by this Second Amendment, the court's prior operational orders remain in full force and effect. The Court's current Emergency Orders authorized by the Chief Justice of California run from March 23, 2020 through and including Friday, April 17, 2020, subject to the possibility of an extension upon the Court's timely request. These court operations orders will remain in effect until further notice.

#### **Pending Traffic and Non-Traffic Infraction Cases**

1. Effective immediately, any promise to appear signed by a defendant in an infraction case requiring the defendant to appear in court on a specific date, scheduled between March 23, 2020 to and including April 17, 2020, is vacated on the court's own motion. The court will reset the arraignment (or other pre-trial proceeding) for a later date, and give notice in writing to the defendant at his address of record. The court will not allow any request for an arraignment (or other pre-trial proceeding) prior to the promise to appear date stated in the citation, or the court re-scheduling notice, whichever is later.
2. Any infraction court trial previously scheduled for a date in April 2020 is hereby vacated and rescheduled by the court. Cases in which there is no time waiver will be rescheduled, pursuant to the court's emergency authority approved by the Chief Justice, to a date within 30 days of the last date the trial could have been otherwise timely set. Notice of the rescheduled court trial will be given by the clerk in writing to the defendant at his or her address-of-record, or to his or her attorney, if represented by counsel. Cases in which there is a time waiver for court trial will be rescheduled by the court to a trial date in June

2020, (or later if the arresting officer is not available to testify at an available trial date in June). Notice of the rescheduled court trial will be given by the clerk in writing to the defendant at his or her address-of-record, or to his or her attorney, if represented by counsel.
